

# **Portable Signs Policy**

### Objective

The objective of the Shire of Cocos (Keeling) Islands portable sign policy is to manage the number of portable advertising signs in such a manner that will enable businesses to advertise and provide information to the public without compromising public safety and visual amenity.

### **Policy**

The requirements of this policy cover all portable signs.

#### **Definitions**

Prior to erecting any sign, permission must be obtained from the shire.

Permission is NOT however required for any business wanting to erect 1 portable sign under the following conditions:

## The portable sign must:

- o Be maintained in a good condition
- Only contain content relating to the business or the business activity
- o Be erected immediately adjacent to the building or business
- o Only be erect during the hours that business is trading
- o Be a minimum 30m away from any intersection
- Be free standing
- o Be placed as to not obstruct or impede the vision of a driver of a vehicle

#### The portable sign must not:

- o Obstruct or impede the reasonable use of the road verge
- o Be placed on any footpath
- o Be rotating, illuminating or have changeable messages
- o Be affixed to any existing sign post, power or light pole or similar structure

Before placing a portable sign the business must have a current insurance policy with a minimum amount of five (5) million dollars for public liability

### Penalties

- o An authorised officer of the Shire of Cocos (Keeling) Islands can impound a portable sign found to be in breach of this policy
- o If the owner of the impounded sign is known he/she will be notified within 1 working day
- An impoundment fee of \$50 will be required to be paid for the return of the sign
- o Impounded signs will be kept for a minimum of 21 days and may be destroyed after this time if not collected before hand

# Relevant Legislation/Local Law

A portable sign is a portable advertising device which is located outside of the premise from which the commodity or service described on the sign may be obtained.
