

Motor Vehicles on Home Island Policy

Responsible Officer

Objective

To encourage road safety and minimise the impact of motorised vehicles on paved roads, through the restriction of passenger vehicles and utilities being imported to Home Island.

Scope

This policy applies to the importation of all passenger vehicles, except emergency vehicles, to Home Island.

Policy

- 1. The importations of passenger vehicles and utilities to Home Island will not be approved and Council will refuse to issue a motor vehicle registrations licence to passenger vehicles and utilities arriving on Home Island after 1st March 2008.
- 2. Emergency vehicles be exempt from this restriction
- 3. Council will consider the licensing of commercial vehicles on Home Island where it can be demonstrated that the use is for bona fide commercial purposes.
- 4. Vehicles approved for importation to Home Island for commercial purposes cannot be used for private use or outside of work hours.
